CBRNE Ltd lead Tasks 5.5 looking into the Characterisation of selected methods to reduce management and operational errors involving human factors helped by the Politecnico di Milano and Studiengesellschaft für den Kombinierten Verkehr e. V. (SGKV). The Work Description required special attention be paid to factors relating to humans and organisations and the use of the proposed technology solutions. For closing “Human Factor” “security gap” both the importance of developing a robust security culture and the importance of human behaviour and security related performance measurement were identified as being critical issues.

CBRNE Ltd lead Task 5.6 providing an analysis of social and ethical issues and was supported by the Politecnico di Milano.
